To register for the meeting and seminar, please send a registration e-mail to sihteeri@hatutus.org deadline to **Friday March 12th at 12:00**. The cost of the meeting will be approximately €90 (additional €14 for non-members) including one hotel night in a shared 2 beds room and a la carte dinner (the Sky hotel restaurant was recently ranked as the 15th best restaurant in Finland). Add additional €40 for a single room and €40/€75 for extra nights. The default menu is a typical Lapland meal including fish as a starter and game as the main dish. If you wish to select other meal preference: only meat, only fish, vegetarian - please note that in Lapland vegetarian basically means: no food at all (green stuff is reserved for rabbits and reindeers :-)

Note, that there are very convenient night trains to Rovaniemi from the southern Finland (arrive 8am to Rovaniemi) and also frequent flights.
