

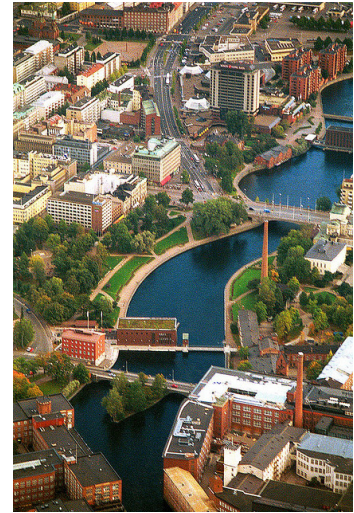


”THE HUNT FOR THE NOBEL PRIZE: MEDICAL IMAGING”
